(Subject + get/have + object + verb in participle)

Exercises:

Ex: The optician checked my sight last month → I had/got my sight checked last month.

1- Someone is repairing the tv right now.

I am getting/having my tv repaired right now. \_\_\_\_\_

2- Carla will dye my hair next week.

I will get/have my hair dyed next week \_\_\_\_\_

3- Someone should shorten your dress for the wedding.

You should get/have your dress shortened for the wedding. \_\_\_\_\_

4- The builders can't build my house until next year.

I can't have/get my house built until next year. \_\_\_\_\_

5- The housekeeper has cleaned my hotel room thoroughly.

I have got/had my hotel room cleaned thoroughly. \_\_\_\_\_

6- My students usually rub out the blackboard before the class.

I usually get/have the blackboard rubbed out before the class. \_\_\_\_\_
